

Loving Friends Music Box

FABRIC LAYOUT

Baste the lines shown on the Fabric Layout Diagram. Then mark the centers of each of the sections.

Models: 28ct “Raw Linen” Cashel
1 piece 11” wide x 20” high

Box Lid Top: 28ct “Raw Linen” Cashel
1 piece - 9” wide x 7” high

Pincushion Top: 28ct “Raw Linen” Cashel
1 piece - 5” wide x 5” high

Pincushion Bottom: 28ct “Raw Linen” Cashel
1 piece - 5” wide x 5” high

Pincushion Side 1 and 3: 28ct “Raw Linen” Cashel
2 pieces - 5” wide x 2 1/2” high

Pincushion Side 2 and 4: 28ct “Raw Linen” Cashel
2 pieces - 2 1/2” wide x 5” high

Scissors Fob: 28ct “Raw Linen” Cashel
1 piece - 4” wide x 4” high

Getting started:

1. Unpack your kit and sort your threads according to the BUNDLES shown on the Materials list of your Leaflet. Sorting your threads is easier if you sort ONE Bundle at a time. Each bundle has one easily identifiable thread in it, so take out each bundle, identify the ones you know first, and then identify the ones left. Label them or put them in plastic baggies for your project.

2. Overcast or zig zag raw edges of fabric to prevent unraveling. Work basting lines on fabric as shown on diagram at right. You can also remove fabric threads at the basting lines to save time. Removing one thread marks your cutting lines beautifully! Then baste the horizontal and vertical centers of each section to prepare for stitching.

3. A roller frame is recommended to prevent distortion and handling of the fabric. Each of the specialty stitches, including back stitch, can be started with a waste knot as follows: make a knot at the end of the thread, and push threaded needle through the front of the fabric near the whipstitched edge. Come up at the appropriate spot and begin stitching. Later, cut the knot from the front of the fabric,

1/4” to attach to roller bars↑

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Box Top
9” wide x 7” high

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Pincushion Top
5” wide x 5” high

Pincushion Bottom
5” wide x 5” high

Pincushion Side 1
5” wide x 2 1/2” high

Pincushion Side 3
5” wide x 2 1/2” high

Pincushion Side 2
2 1/2” wide x 5” high

Pincushion Side 4
2 1/2” wide x 5” high

Scissor Fob
4” wide x 4” high

Left
Over

1/4” to attach to roller bars↓

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pull the tail to the back and carefully weave through stitches already in place. Give yourself plenty of thread to finish these waste knots, after you’ve finished stitching.
